Each year American Legion Post 759 of Chatham awards two \$500 scholarships to college-bound seniors from Glenwood High School. One scholarship each will be awarded to a male and female student based upon academic performance, community service, and other criteria.

All applications must be received by April 15 and the awards will be announced in early May. The scholarships are payable upon satisfactory completion of the first semester or quarter of college with a minimum 2.8 grade point average (on a four-point basis).

Please note that, in sections 3 and 4, the application requests the number of hours completed for these activities in the last three years. The information should be your best estimate of the total amount of time spent at these activities during the entire three-year period.
